SNAP BENEFITS

1. There is a 15% increase in SNAP allotments through the end of September 2021.
2. SNAP emergency allotment- automatically being dispersed to all enrolled households around mid-month until state public health emergency ends, will provide a minimum of \$95 in extra food aid.

1. Matching dollars available for fruit and vegetable purchases made with an EBT card (SNAP) at participating farmers markets

2. Increase in Senior Farmers Market and WIC Farmers Markets Coupons to \$20

WOMEN, INFANTS & CHILDREN (WIC)

Increase in the monthly value of fresh fruits and vegetables from WIC benefits from June-September 2021. Total of \$35 now per recipient.

SCHOOL FEEDING

1. P-EBT (Pandemic EBT) was distributed for eligible children on April 25 who are not learning in person to replace meals they would have received at school. These funds can be used anywhere that accepts SNAP benefits

2. Free summer meal service will continue beginning late June through August.
